

## Introduction

Each week has seven daily assignments which should take between 15 and 30 minutes each. Days 1 through 6 focus mainly on observation and interpretation. Day 7 pulls together the previous 6 days' work and brings in application. We will focus our discussion on Day 7's questions.

Even if you aren't able to complete all the assignments, do come to class. You can still learn a lot from the discussion.

Day 7 also includes a memory verse to "store in your heart." I strongly encourage you to work on memorizing those verses.

- A Bible
- The text of 1 & 2 Thessalonians suitable for marking up (this can be your Bible if you want)
- Colored pens or pencils for marking the text
- A notebook for writing down your insights and observations. There is no space for writing answers in the study guide.
